

Celebrating Mathematical Progress Through Century Tech



Secondary students have been making excellent use of the Century Tech platform to support their mathematics learning. In addition to the two mathematics homework tasks set weekly by their teachers, many students are also choosing to use the platform independently. They are doing so either to consolidate their understanding of topics already covered in class or to explore and learn new mathematical concepts.

Students also benefit from immediate feedback on every question they attempt, allowing them to learn from mistakes in real time. The platform currently hosts 58,650 mathematics questions across all ability levels, ensuring there is always more practice available. Across all subjects on Century Tech, there are 181,885 questions in total, and this number continues to grow rapidly each day.



Century Tech offers short, focused mini-lessons known as “nuggets.” Each nugget provides students with access to explanatory videos and slideshows on a specific topic, followed by a diagnostic test. Using artificial intelligence, the platform analyses students’ responses and identifies areas of strength and improvement. Based on this analysis, Century Tech recommends additional nuggets that are tailored to each student’s ability level. This ensures that every learner follows a personalised mathematics pathway that is completely unique to them.
